

Going Backwards

It is said that history repeats itself. This is probably due to the inability of mankind to:

- learn from its own historical mistakes,
- to accept what others have done, AND
- the desire of individuals to leave their “mark” or legacy.

We will leave the historical actions for the moment and look at two examples of the second and third reason.

Example 1.

In this example, let's consider employee evaluation program. Most large organizations, businesses, and government agencies have some form of employee evaluation. As these entities grow and change, and as social norms change, the evaluation processes often changes as well. While there are many problems with these changes, the primary problem is that the processes tend to move away from measurable skills and abilities and toward esoteric, non-measurable social intercourse areas such as communications, personality, teamwork, etc. with increasing emphasis on the social aspects rather than skills and abilities.

The second major problem is that whatever group is working on the “new” evaluation process, they tend to discount what has been done in the past, AND to discount the processes developed by other entities. For example, several years ago the US Army spent almost a half billion dollars to revamp both its officers and enlisted evaluation processes. After the new system was put into effect, several state agencies and their subordinate groups started revamping their own processes. None of the state agencies or subordinate groups even considered aspect of the Army's new system. Consequently, two things happened. Each group wasted at least \$500,000 of taxpayer money, and their newly developed process was often fraught with pitfalls and invidious actions.

Example 2.

Most people desire to leave their mark or legacy when they move from one “activity” or another. For example, the mark/legacy of Biden will probably be one of weakness, poor leadership, and womanizer. Another example is when some organization puts a person in charge of some ongoing committee such as planning a retiring ceremony. Instead of following the status quo of past committee chairs, the newly appointed chair ignores the past in order to make the ceremony “theirs.” In other words, pride and selfishness are

at the root that drives the changes, forgetting about or ignoring tradition, norms and “law.”

Instead of building on the past, Biden is reinventing the “wheel” of government. Unfortunately his concept of what government should be is not one of the people, by the people, but rather one where a few dictate to the many how they will live.

For decades, the US made great strides in bringing equality to America. Today, however, the far left, Democrats, and socialists want to deny these strides by taking America backwards. Their “Critical Race Theory” (CRT) does nothing but create racism which leads to segregation and worse.

While CRT, on the surface, for most people, is about race and color, more insidiously infiltrates and traps your mind with the belief that ANY GROUP that is not like-minded is inferior, and subordinate to you.

Our nation overtly experienced CRT with the enslavement of Blacks. We experienced it again with Japanese-Americans during WW-II. Covertly it is played out with different ethnic and religious groups which are discriminated against. During WW-II the Nazi Germany embraced CRT with their Jewish genocide programs. Later CRT was exhibited in South Africa with apartheid. And more recently, we saw it in the ethnic cleanings between Yugoslavia and Croatia.

From another perspective, CRT is also being used to create another two groups – those who have been vaccinated and those who have not. This is a MOST dangerous situation as individuals, businesses, and governments are now calling for people to show “Covid passports” in order to receive or buy goods and services. This practice is not new. In fact it was practiced from 1938 to 1945.

In 1938, during Nazi Germany’s pre-Holocaust period, the nightmare began. While the Nazi’s anti-Semitic rhetoric was well entrenched since 1933, in November of 1938, the Nazi’s decreed that Jews were forbidden to operate stores, sell goods, provide services or participate in a trade. The Nazis implemented laws requiring Jews to provide documentation as to their heritage and religion. The laws also required the Jews to be visibly “marked” by wearing a special “badge” or armband, and that their identification papers indicate that they were Jewish. The Nazi government also called for attacks on Jewish communities, and eventually the killing of Jews throughout Europe.

The Nazis portrayed Jews as sub-human, inferior, and primarily interested in their own economic gain. They were Hitler's scapegoat for Germany's economic and social problems.

Today, we are reliving the history of 1938, not from the aspect of anyone being Jewish, but rather if we have been vaccinated or not.

Like the German passports of 1938 that indicated if a person was Jewish or not, our passports today (called Covid-19 Vaccination Record Cards) indicate if we have been vaccinated. These cards are our "badges" allowing us to:

- Be employed
- Enroll in schools
- Go shopping
- Receive services
- Travel to where we want

Like 1938, everyone in Germany had to show their paper they were demanded, Democrats today want Americans to show their "papers" as well. Ironically the papers are for Covid-19 vaccination and not for voting in federal elections or whether you are an illegal alien or criminal.

Like 1938, when Jews were not allowed to work, travel, business and their businesses were labeled non-essential, Democrat governors have followed in the Nazi footsteps in their lockdowns and selected "reopening" of their states.

Like 1938, when Jews were required to wear badges, our government has issued mask mandates. This has also trickled down to local governments requiring them as well. Your freedom of choice – to wear or not wear masks – was taken away by the Democratic leaders.

Like 1938, the media was used as the Nazi's public relations arm. The media spouted vitriol hatred toward the Jews. The media today follows in the Nazi's footsteps by censoring free speech, misleading "facts," and "damning" the unvaccinated.

Like 1938, when Hitler encouraged the door-to-door attacks on Jews and Jewish businesses, our own Hitler (aka: Biden) is pushing for an army of door-to-door vaccine pushers. It will probably not be long before he also pushes a similar army to go door-to-door and grab your guns.

Like 1938, when Hitler and the Nazis issued mandates to the Jewish people, Biden and the Democrats have been and are continuing to issue mandates.
