Racial slurs do not just appear overnight. They generally come about through a stereotyping process, especially as negative portrayals of specific groups. Over the years the social and government definitions for various races have changed. For example:

As races are segregated into specific groups and the groups become stereotyped, derogatory terms (slurs) tend to emerge.

A relatively new slur has emerged and is being bantered around in today's contemporary living – "White Supremacist."

The slur is applied to anyone who disagrees with the leftist and socialist's views and ideas. It is also used when teaching "Critical Race Theory."
